**ROCK YOUR RIGHT TO
CONFIDENTIALITY**

You have the **RIGHT TO A CONFIDENTIAL HEALTH SERVICE** when you visit a **GP or Health Professional**. (However under 16yrs you may be encouraged to speak to a parent or carer).



What is **CONFIDENTIALITY**?

Your personal information will be kept safe and will not be shared. This can include:

Mental health, Sex & Relationships, Drugs & Alcohol.

However if you share information where you or another young person is at risk of serious harm this can be shared with an appropriate person/agency.

ROCK YOUR RIGHT TO FEEDBACK

You have the right to complain/feedback about any aspect of your NHS treatment using the NHS complaints procedure.

**ROCK YOUR RIGHT TO
HEALTH RECORDS**

You have the **RIGHT TO CONFIDENTIAL HEALTH RECORDS**. This means you have a right to see your own health records but parents/carers/others do not unless agreed by **YOU**.

However when under 16yrs health professionals can share with parents/carers if they believe you do not have the capacity to make a health decision.

**ROCK YOUR RIGHT TO
HEALTH TREATMENT**

You have the **RIGHT TO GIVE CONSENT TO TREATMENT** from a health professional without parental knowledge.

However when under 16yrs the health professional must agree that you are capable of understanding the nature and consequences of the medical advice.
